

## Unless It Gets \$10,000

# **Escambia Search, Rescue Unit to Stop Service—**

Escambia Search and Rescue Unit is going to curtail its activities—unless it receives \$10,000 in donations in its current three-day drive.

That was the statement made by J. E. Buchanan, deputy director, Monday night.

Buchanan said \$278 had been

donated Monday. "Unless we get better support then some of our facilities will be curtailed."

He said the unit would not be on 24-hour call, and would be forced to spend "less time on missions."

Buchanan said the unit had answered 120 calls in the last 18 and a half months. "We've never failed the public, but we will unless we get support."

He said the \$10,000 is to be used for equipment.

Contributions, he said, will be received any time Tuesday and Wednesday by telephones HEmlock 2-4092, 8-8663 and 2-3815. Contributions will be picked up 6-9 p.m., he said.
