The Escambia County Search and Rescue Squad was called to Fort Morgan, Ala., Thursday night on a report a Florida-registered boat was found adrift, according to E. E. McGovern, director.

McGovern said report on the boat was made by Stephen Pugley of Ft. Morgan and that the craft, upon which was mounted an 18 horsepower motor, had a ski rope in tangled in the propeller.
